

Doral places 4th at FAU event

Doral Academy Charter placed 4th overall at the Mu Alpha Theta Regional Math Competition held at FAU on January 20th. Over 1500 students participated.

Doral had two first place awards - the interschool award, in which the whole school participated, and the individual Precalculus award. Logan Fontirroche had the highest score of the 273 precalculus students taking this test from almost 60 schools.

The Precalculus team placed 2nd (Fontirroche, Allan DoLago, Raul Valle, Irena Lian). Valle placed 3rd, Marc Marquez placed 7th, and DoLago 11th on the individual test.

The Geometry team from Doral Middle placed 2nd (Kevin Rodriguez, Tony Wong, Veronica Alvarez, Samantha Cervone); Rodriguez placed 15th on the individual test. Manuel Rodriguez from Doral High placed 7th on the individual test.

The Algebra I team from Doral Middle placed 3rd (Anna Sofia Arevalo, Natalie Chung, Vaishnavi Kappagantula, Noah Clough); Chung placed 3rd, Kappagantula 7th, Arevalo 14th, and Mukul Vinod 15th in individuals.

The Algebra II team from Doral Middle placed 4th (Amanda Miyares, Alberto Alvarez, Sofia Garcia, Steven Diaz); Miyares placed 9th; Daniel Rodriguez-Florida 10th; Alvarez 13th; and Garcia 14th on the individual test.

The high school Algebra II team placed 5th (Tae Lee, Alejandro Almanzar, Maria Pelayo, Daniel Pita); Lee placed 4th in individuals.

The Calculus team placed 4th (Anirudh Rahul, Karanveer Sandhu, Tomas Alvarez, Amanda Fernandez) and the Statistics team placed 5th (Carlos Estrada, Bin Zheng, Jose Romero, and Giovanni Ferioli.)
